

Member Services Policies

Application

- 1) Application will contain two parts (November 2019)
 - a. Application
 - b. Receipt
- 2) Application will also serve as the renewal form (November 2019)
- 3) Cash receipt # or Check # will be on both parts of the application (November 2019)
- 4) Application form will be filled out at the time of application/renewal and will be kept on file with the Vice-President (November 2019)

Dues

- 1) Membership is due by the 10th of the month, all payments must be made by the end of the month to prevent a lapse in membership. (November 2019)
- 2) Annual membership is due on June 10th. (November 2019)
- 3) Any member who has a lapse in membership must wait 90 days to regain voting privileges. (November 2019)
- 4) Membership is Non-Refundable under any circumstances. (Jan 2016)
- 5) Dues are \$60 annually or \$20 every three months. (November 2019)

Members Confidentiality

- 1) Member's information is confidential and cannot be used for personal use by anyone under any circumstances. (November 2019)
- 2) Member's information is confidential, it cannot be given to anyone without prior written authorization from the member. This authorization must be documented with a letter with their signature or an email from the member per situation. (November 2019)

- 1) You will lose your voting rights during this or you can opt to put your membership on hold until it the situation is finalized. (March 2018)
- 2) The Serenity Club reserve the right to cancel your membership after the situation has been finalized. (March 2018)

Rights & Responsibilities
